Melissa Roy Elected Chair of Detroit Public TV's Board of Trustees

Detroit (March 8, 2023) – Detroit Public TV's board of trustees has elected Melissa Roy, managing partner at Lambert Global, as its new chair. She succeeds Timothy Nicholson, chief operating officer at PVS Chemicals, Inc, who served 12 years as a Detroit Public TV (DPTV) board trustee and will continue in service as an emeritus trustee.

The board also named Simon Whitelocke, president of ITC Michigan and vice president, ITC Holdings Corporation, as chair elect.

Prior to launching Roy Public Affairs, she created and grew the business and community leadership organization, Advancing Macomb, as a primary philanthropic organization in Macomb County. Before that, she served as assistant county executive with

Macomb County government and spent 12 years with the Detroit Regional Chamber as senior director of Government Relations, leading federal, state and local government relationship management. She resides in Detroit.
